Pinay writer nagwagi sa 2026 CBC Short Story prize



Ang Filipino Canadian na si Larah Luna ang nanalo sa 2026 CBC Short Story Prize

Pinay na ipinanganak sa Pilipinas at lumaki sa Manitoba ang nanalo sa CBC Short Story Prize para sa taong ito 2026.

Siya ay si Larah Luna, isang communications at marketing professional na nakabase sa Vancouver. Ang istorya ng Filipina Canadian na pinamagatang **A Season of Crows** ang napiling winner ng mga hurado na sina Maria Reva, Terry Fallis at Tracey Lindberg.

Ang mga hurado ay pumili ng winner mula sa halos 3,000 submissions ang lumahok para sa taong ito. Ang mga isinumite na maikling kuwento ay hinusgahan batay sa paggamit ng wika, originality ng paksa at istilo ng pagsusulat.

Ang apat na iba pang finalist ay sina: Amber Allen ng Guelph, Ont. para sa **Pattern Recognition**. Kate Cayley ng Toronto para sa **Anniversary**; Carrie Mac ng Vancouver para sa **How to Break Up with a Monster** at Andy Stefan ng Ottawa para sa **Low Water**.

Ang **A Season of Crows** ay tungkol sa isang maliit na bayan na natutong mamuhay kasama ang mga uwak na dumadayo sa bayan.

Si Luna ay nag-uwi ng \$6,000 mula sa Canada Council for the Arts, isang dalawang linggo na writing residency sa Banff Centre for Arts and Creativity at inilathala ang kanyang istorya sa CBC Books.

Nang tanungin ni Mattea Roach sa isang panayam sa programang Bookends kung ano ang naramdaman pagkatapos ng kanyang panalo, sinabi ni Luna na siya ay nabigla.

I'm shocked and stunned but in a very good way. Being able to submit this story even in the very beginning, like I just didn't know where it was going to go. It was the first time that I have publicly shared some personal creative writing, aniya.

Isang karangalan aniya ang mapabilang sa mga magagaling na manunulat. It's thrilling and it

is such an honour just being in the companion of so many other talented writers out there. So I'm just really, really honoured and just awestruck.

Kuwento rin ni Luna kay Roach na isang kaibigan ang humikayat sa kanya na sumali sa CBC Short Story Prize. At sa katunayan, isinumite niya ang maikling kuwento kalahating oras bago ang deadline. Ngunit ang istoryang ito ay matagal nang namamalagi sa kanyang isip at siya ay natutuwa, na sa wakas, nadala na niya ito sa finish line.

Mga uwak sa kalangitan

Nang tinanong ni Roach kung bakit mga uwak ang napili ni Luna na maging sentro ng kanyang kuwento, sinabi niya na nagmula ito sa isang karanasan noong kanyang kabataan.

Nag-migrate si Luna sa Canada noong siya ay 10 taong gulang at lumaki sa Manitoba. Dito niya unang nakita ang pagtitipon ng mga uwak sa kalangitan sa panahon ng taglagas, isang imahe na

hindi niya nakalimutan hanggang sa pagtanda.

Ang imahe na ito na kinataktan niya noong siya ay bata pa ang nag-udyok din kay Luna na maging curious para malaman ang higit pa tungkol sa mga ibon na ito. Sinabi niya kay Roach, You know you were saying about [the crows] like how it even seems so foreboding and scary, that's how I felt. But I think as a child it also just drove that curiosity in me to find out more about it.

Sinabi rin ni Luna sa panayam ni Daphné Santos-Vieira ng CBC Books na ang pagpanaw ng kanyang ina at ang kalungkutan na kanyang naramdaman ay hinubog din ang istorya. Kuwento ni Luna sa CBC Books, "The story was also shaped by my own experience of grief after the loss of my mother, and the sense that it doesn't simply disappear, but settles into the world around us. From there, the story grew into an exploration of how memory, loss and place become intertwined." - RCI

Ang mga hukom sa International Criminal Court (ICC) itinakda ang Nobyembre 30 bilang start date para sa paglilitis sa dating pangulo ng Pilipinas na si Rodrigo Duterte, na kinasuhan ng mga krimen laban sa sangkatauhan dahil sa kanyang nakamamatay na war on drugs.

Kinasuhan ng ICC si Duterte, 81-anyos, ng tatlong counts of crimes against humanity kaugnay ng pagpatay sa hindi bababa sa 76 katao at attempted murder ng dalawa pang indibidwal.

Sinabi ng prosekusyon na ang umano'y krimen ay naganap sa loob ng anti-narcotics campaign ni Duterte, na sinasabi nila ay pinatay ang libo-libong sibilyan sa pagitan ng 2016 at 2022.

May mga grupo na ipinanawagan sa ICC na ipaaresto ang ibang co-perpetrators ni Duterte.

Si Duterte na winaive ang kanyang karapatan na maging present sa pagdinig kamakailan, ay matagal nang iginiit na inutusan niya ang pulis na pumatay lamang in

self-defence at palaging ipinagtanggol ang crackdown.

Inaresto si Duterte at dinala sa The Hague noong Marso 2025 at nakaku-

long hanggan ngayon sa detention centre ng ICC.

Sinabi ng mga abogado para sa dating pangulo na siya ay unfit upang humarap sa paglilitis dahil sa cognitive decline, ngunit ang korte nagdesisyon sa ngayon na kaya niyang sundan at mag-participate sa mga pagdinig na may kaunting adjustment sa sitting times.

ICC dedesisyunan ang apela kung may kus-todiya ito sa kasong isinampa kay Duterte

Ang mga paglilitis sa ICC, ang permanenteng war crimes court ng mundo, sa pangkalahatan ay nagtatagal ng maraming taon bago umabot sa isang hatol.

Kung mahahatulan, si Duterte ay nahaharap sa pinakamababang sentensya na habambuhay na pagkakakulong. - RCI

Impeachment trial ni VP Sara kasado sa Hulyo 6

PILIPINAS — Maaari nang magsimula ang impeachment trial ni Vice President Sara Duterte sa Hulyo 6, ayon kay Sen. Erwin Tulfo nitong Huwebes.

Sinabi ni Tulfo na may 10 araw para sumagot ang Bise Presidente sa Articles of Impeachment na ipinadala sa kanya kamakalawa samantalang may limang araw naman para tumugon ang prosekusyon o mga kinatawan ng House of Representatives sa trial.

“After 10...calendar days, hindi working days na mag-comply si VP Sara... sasagot yung prosecution na five days. After that, yun na yung mga pre-trial, yung mga marking of pieces of evidence. So we are looking at around talaga na mga July 6 mag-uumpisa na ang ika nga trial,” ani Tulfo sa phone patch interview ng Senate media.

Mas mapapaaga aniya ang trial sa halip na mag-sine die



adjournment ang Senado kaya magkakaroon na ng trial bago ang State of the Nation Address ni Pangulong Ferdinand Marcos sa Hulyo 27, 2026.

Napagkasunduan sa isinagawang caucus ng mga

senador kamakalawa na gagawin ang kanilang regular session mula alas-10 ng umaga hanggang ala-una ng hapon at magkakaroon ng isang oras na break at isusunod na kaagad ang impeachment trial.

“Break po ng one hour, 2 o'clock one to sawa ayun na po yung trial,” sabi pa ni Tulfo.

Pareho rin aniya ang mangyayari tuwing Martes at Miyerkules kung saan magkakaroon din ng trial. Pero tuwing Huwebes aniya ay walang trial at doon gagawin ang mga committee hearings at magkakaroon din ng sesyon.

“So tuluy-tuloy po. Bale, five days na po ‘yung work natin. Magiging day off lang po ng mga senador tuwing Saturday, Sunday,” sabi pa ni Tulfo.

Tiniyak ni Tulfo na bibigyan ng kopya ang media at isasapubliko ang napagkasunduan ‘kalendaryo’ para sa trial.

Base sa legislative calendar, nakatakda sanang magsimula ang sine die adjournment ng Kongreso sa Hunyo 6 hanggang Hulyo 26, 2026.

First Nations chiefs pini-pressure ang Alberta na wakasan ang debate sa separasyon

Mahigit isang dosenang First Nations chiefs at mas marami pang band councillors at elders ang nagtungo sa lehislatura ng Alberta kamakailan, nanawagan sa gobyerno ni Premier Danielle Smith na ibasura ang pagnanais ng probinsya na humiwalay sa Canada.

Our rights are being minimized, sinabi ni Confederacy of Treaty 8 First Nations Grand Chief Trevor Mercredi sa mga reporter.

Our people are being minimized at every level.

Ang mga komento ay dumating matapos manawagan ang First Nations chiefs sa buong probinsya sa mga miyembro ng lehislatura na magsagawa ng isang non-confidence vote laban sa gobyerno dahil sa kung paano nito hinarap ang separatist movement.

Naghain ng mosyon si Opposition NDP Leader Naheed Nenshi na magsagawa ng naturang botohan, ngunit ito ay mabilis na ibinasura ng majority United Conservative Party government ni Smith.

Tinawag ito ni Government House leader Joseph Schow na isang political stunt at kinuwestiyon kung naniniwala si Nenshi sa direktang

demokrasya.

Who do you think you are ... to say Albertans don't have a right to have their voices heard? ani Schow sa house.

Ang mga chief at iba pang mga lider na Indigenous sa gallery ipinahayag ang kanilang frustration bago umalis, ang ilan ay sumigaw sa mga politiko sa ibaba na kondenahin ang separatismo.

Sinabi ni Cold Lake First Nations Chief Kelsey Jacko pagkatapos ng non-confidence vote na ito ay isang pagtatangka to hold the premier to account.

No matter what we say, [Smith] doesn't seem to hear us, ani Jacko sa labas ng lehislatura.

We have been trying to work with her and [her caucus] for years now. She keeps saying we have a great relationship. But how do you have a great relationship with someone who doesn't listen?

Sinabi ni Mercredi na alam niyang hindi papasa ang boto ngunit importante na manindigan.

We knew what [we were] in for when we came to this legislature, aniya.

We've seen it time and time again — the disrespect that the MLAs have for our people in those rooms when they're yawning, texting, leaning back on their chairs [and] smiling. It's very unprofessional.

Ang mga lider na Indigenous ay tutol sa separatist movement sa Alberta. Maraming First Nations ang humahon sa batas ng probinsya sa korte na pinahintulutan ang mga citizen-led na petisyon na nais magkaroon ng referendum votes, tulad ng nagpapatuloy na kampanya upang ilagay sa balota ang separasyon.

Habang maraming lider na Indigenous ang nasa Edmonton, ang iba ay nagbiyahe patungong Inglatera, kung saan ang isang delegasyon mula sa Confederacy of Treaty Six First Nations ay nakatakdang makipagkita kay King Charles.

Karapatan na mag-engage

Sinabi ni Grand Chief Joey Pete sa isang news release na plano niyang pagdiskusyonan ang pagsulong sa separasyon kay King Charles at remind [him] that our relationship is not with provinces or Canada — it is with the Crown.

Treaties are recognized in international law and any

attempt to override them is a violation of the original agreements made between First Nations and the Crown, ayon sa release.

Hindi available si Pete para sa interbyu, at ang Buckingham Palace ay hindi kaagad tumugon sa hiling na magkomento.

Tinawag ito ni Alberta Indigenous Relations Minister Rajan Sawhney na isang tremendous opportunity para sa delegasyon na makipagkita sa Hari.

First Nation leaders have a right to engage with the Crown, ani Sawhney. I think it's totally fine that they're doing so.

Sinabi ni Sawhney na siya ay umaasa na makilala ang ilang lider sa lehislatura at naniniwala siya na tinutugunan niya ang kanilang mga alalahanin tungkol sa separation movement.

I do engage on a regular basis, and I always do affirm that the Constitution is the highest law in the land, and Section 35 rights which protect treaty rights] are entrenched in the Constitution, aniya.

There's no legislation, policy or decision that will ever supersede that. - RCI

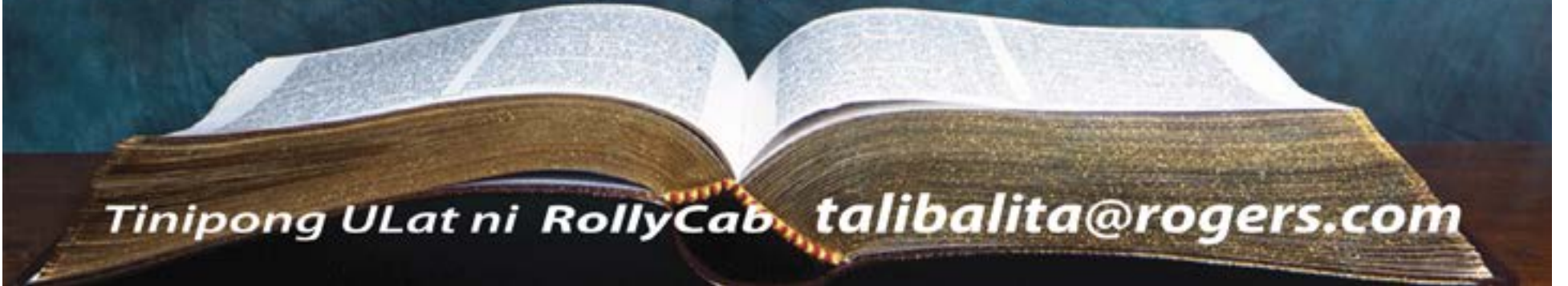
